 - c) Letter of recommendation from your high school counselor or a teacher.
 - d) We will also download a current copy of your **official** transcript. While there is no minimum number of honors or AP classes needed on your transcript, rigor of coursework will be a factor in determining who receives the scholarship.
 - e) The applicant must also show involvement in community and school activities.
